

## Practical information

### Airport

- Helsinki can easily be reached by plane from anywhere in Europe. Helsinki-Vantaa Airport is the main airport in Finland. The airport is situated 19 kilometres from the city centre of Helsinki. Helsinki can also be reached by train, bus or ferry.

### Public transportation

- There is well functioning public transportation in Helsinki. The day ticket 1-7 days <https://www.hsl.fi/en/tickets-and-fares/day-tickets>: for unlimited use on public transport is a very good option for visitors. It is valid in bus, train, tram, metro and ferry services. Day tickets are available for three different zones: city internal, regional and extended regional. The regional one is recommended, because it covers also the train between the airport and the city centre – so it is a very economical option (48 hours – 21 euro, 72 h – 28 euro, 96 h – 35 euro and 120 h – 42 euro) to travel back and forth between the airport and the central railway station of Helsinki. - Please note that it is not possible to buy a ticket in the train.
- The entrance to the train station is in the corridor between the terminals.

### Taxi service between the Airport and the city centre

- A journey by taxi from the airport to the centre of Helsinki takes about 30 minutes and costs around 45 to 50 euros. The taxi stands are located right outside the arrival halls of the terminals.
